

CHOOSING A BRUSH

ALL BRUSHES MAY LOOK THE SAME AT FIRST GLANCE, BUT ONCE YOU KNOW WHICH PAINT YOU ARE PLANNING TO USE, THE MYSTERY IS SOLVED. WE INTRODUCE THREE ROKSET BRUSH TYPES.

FILAMENT

Man-made synthetic filament brushes are just the thing for water based paints. These brushes are especially easy to clean, water just takes the paint out of the brush in a flash. You will be surprised. They are very hard wearing, long lasting and light to hold.

BRISTLE + FILAMENT BLEND

The blend brush is a good, general purpose, all rounder. The balanced filament and bristle composition gives a smooth finish while holding more paint (less dips into the tin to fill the brush) than a filament brush. It's a lighter weight than a bristle brush.

NATURAL BRISTLE

Hog bristles are fabulous for oil based paints. They are hollow and fill with paint so the brush holds more. The natural split ends (not a good look for a great hairdo but terrific in a brush) are an asset and make the finish smoother, so don't buy a bristle brush with a crew cut. Rokset trims the bristles from the base to keep this natural feature intact.
